What is Libby?

- Libby is a free app where you can borrow ebooks and digital audiobooks from your public library. You can stream books with Wi-Fi or mobile data, or download them for offline use and read anytime, anywhere.

What can you do on Libby?

- Discover ebooks and audiobooks from your local library through Libby.
- Download content for offline reading, or stream them to save space.
- If you prefer reading on a Kindle, Libby can send your library books to your device.
- Positions, bookmarks, and notes are kept in sync across your devices.


How do I get Libby?

- Make sure your smart device is connected to the internet and you have your library card handy!
- Head to your device's app market and search for Libby, By Overdrive. Download and install as you would any other app.
- Open the app, and follow the prompts to establish your account
- Enjoy Libby!

How Do I Navigate Libby?



Search: Locate ebooks and audiobooks by title or author. Some titles will be available to borrow immediately, others will need to be placed on hold until they become available.



Livebrary: From here you can see the main Livebrary page, a place where you can see various lists of available ebooks and audiobooks.



Notifications: This opens the notifications panel.



Shelf: From here you can manage your holds, renew items, download titles, and access items you have already checked out.



Timeline: This shows you your history, when items were checked out, placed on hold, renewed, and returned

Now Reading: Clicking this brings you right back to your current ebook or audiobook. Also, you can get back to your current read or listen by finding the title on your shelf.
